Dear Institute Participants:

We have an excellent week planned for you in June at California State University-Monterey Bay. The faculty and University staff are busily preparing for this exciting experience.

The [campus map](#) should assist in your journey to CSUMB. Dorm check-in will be on Monday, June 25th, 3:30-6:30 p.m. and Institute check-in Tuesday, June 26th from 6:30-8:00 a.m. (for details see enclosed campus map). A binder, tote bag, name tag, and 1 parking permit, if needed, will be issued at check-in. You may check-in first and then place your parking permit on your dashboard after orientation, by 9:00 am.

The welcoming event and orientation will begin at 8:00 a.m. in the University Center Ballroom on Tuesday, June 26th. Participants will receive an overview of campus life, areas of interest, review of internet access and passwords, and the week in review.

Each subject session will begin on Tuesday morning at 9:00 a.m. The remainder of the week sessions will begin at 8:00 a.m. As a general rule, the instructors would like you to bring a successful lesson to share with the other participants. You may contact the presenters via the Institute's website for specific details.

Dorm housing includes three meals per day from Monday dinner through Friday lunch. Everyone will be provided with mid-morning snack and lunch Wednesday through Friday. Please see the schedule of events for details regarding lunch.

The summer [Monterey Peninsula weather](#) average high is in the mid-60s and the average low is 48°. A sweater or windbreaker will enhance your enjoyment of the evenings and mornings when it is overcast. The midday temperatures can be warm on a June day.

A campus parking permit for your use during the Institute will be issued at check-in. **Please display it on your dashboard, at all times, when parked on campus.** However, do not park in spaces marked "Faculty/Staff" or "Reserved only." **Parking regulations are enforced on a 24-hour, 7 day a week basis.** If your parking permit is lost you will need to purchase a new permit.

Communication during the Institute will be facilitated by a daily newsletter as articulated by your instructor.

For those with Wi-Fi accessible laptops, there are Internet accessible areas around the campus. Sign-on and password instructions will be provided during the orientation session.
